



More than **13 million** teens volunteer annually.

More than **6 million** teens volunteer annually because they are asked to volunteer.

Teen volunteers annually contribute about **2 billion** hours of service.

Most teens start volunteering before the age of 14.

The majority of teens see volunteering as an outlet for developing their leadership and citizenship skills.

Most teen volunteers say their work provides them with an improved sense of kindness, increased awareness for those in need, and a better sense of coping with cultural diversity.

Teens devote more time toward religion, education, youth development and the environment than all other service activities.
