Approval of District Minutes as printed in the Official District Call, mailed 30 days prior to this meeting

Sharon O’Neil/Chuck Davis approved minutes with changes, motion passed.

Approval of Financials as printed in the Official Call, mailed 30 days prior to this meeting – 1st and 2nd months of the 4th quarter only. Sharon O’Neil/ Judy Martinson – **4th quarter 2010-2011** – Financials will be finalized at the 2nd Quarter Conference in.

Motion passed.

2011-2012 – Proposed Financials printed in the Official District Call, mailed 30 days prior to this meeting. Any corrections/changes, added \$1000 in receipts/disbursements for the scholarship fund; in the event the Ohio District will hold the CCDHH during the 201-2012 year. – Sharon O’Neil/Chuck Davis. Motion passed.

Open Issues

Update on club delinquent in dues – Hamilton has not accepted the registered return receipt letter the S/T sent. They have made arrangements with OI to pay their dues by the end of October. Hopefully, they will pay us also. Muskingum was behind in their dues but they have been paid by a member. Urbana has sent a letter asking their club to be disbanded. Their dues will be erased.

New Business

The following three proposals are to be voted on at the Executive Meeting on Friday, October 14, 2011; then approved by the Board of Directors on Saturday, October 15, 2011. According to the Ohio District Policies, it was received by the District Secretary-Treasurer at least 60 days prior to the distribution of the District Call. The District Call was mailed/e-mail at least 30 days prior to the 1st Quarter District Conference.

1. I would like to make a proposal for consideration of an amendment to add to the Great Ohio District Policies in reference to the Oratorical contest.

In the past the Ohio District has added \$1,000 to the winners (one boy, one girl) of the district oratorical contest. I recommend the policy be changed to: “The non-winners would each receive One Hundred dollars (\$100) as a consolation gift; the two winners will each receive \$1,000. By approving this change, the District would need to raise an additional \$400.00 per year.

I make this motion to make this effective, October 1, 2011.

This has been tabled until further research is completed.

2. **I propose that the Ohio JOOI District Governor's registration be paid for by the Ohio District to represent the JOOI District. This should cover registration and lunch for district meetings and conferences.**

3. **Forgiveness of Dues** – I proposed that the Ohio District forgives the Muskingum College Club their past dues amount of \$2.50. After numerous attempts, I have been unable to collect this amount. See note below. Request for the Ohio District to forgive the amount of \$2.50 from Muskingum University. The Office at Muskingum does not have a record of having

an optimist club on campus. I have requested the sponsoring club, the Lt. Gov. and/or 2010-2011 Governor to check into this. So far, I have heard nothing. If not a club, we need to pick up bell, gavel and banner. Since this was mailed, the club has added 2 or 3 new members. Lt.Gov. Chuck Davis will visit club.
